FROM OUR RABBI

What's in a Pomegranate?

Israel and stayed in the Katamon neighborhood of Jerusalem. One sunny morning, we went to the park and beheld the sight of still green pomegranates on the tree. Aviel snapped a photo, and the picture hangs on our wall to this day.

The Rimon (pomegranate) is one of the seven species Moshe referenced to praise

the land of Israel and its beauty (Devarim 8, 8). Whenever I look at this picture, I think about my deep love for the land and the people of Israel.

This spring, as we embrace a new chapter of rejuvenation, our synagogue is rebranding. In that process, we are developing a new look to help more people connect with the unique taste our Shul has to offer.

As we shared at our recent Town Hall meeting, we have

developed a new logo to help us as we spread our message far and wide. When our graphic designer suggested the theme of a pomegranate, I was intrigued. I thought about those pomegranates we saw in Israel.

The Rimon is not only one of the seven fruits but was a common symbol in Solomon's Temple. Pomegranate shaped bells lined the High Priests robe, and the Rimon image was featured in many other aspects of the Temple art and architecture, as referenced in Kings I. Today, one of the largest Kosher supermarkets in Brooklyn is known simply as "Pomegranate."

But while the Rimon is a classic Jewish symbol, what does it have to do with our synagogue? A critical part of our new brand is our tagline: **the Orthodox synagogue for ALL Jews**. Here at Sons of Israel, we aspire

> to be a welcoming Shul for Jews of all backgrounds and levels of observance. This idea is exactly what the Rimon represents.

> About six years ago, my then seven-year-old daughter was excited to explain why we have a pomegranate on the Rosh HaShana table. She proudly exclaimed that "each Rimon has 613 seeds…just like we keep all of the 613 Mitzvot!" While I am not

sure about the precise number of seeds, she had the right idea.

In the sixth chapter of Shir HaShirim (Song of Songs), God tells the Jewish people that, "your cheeks are like the slice of pomegranate, from behind your modest veil." According to the Talmud, this means that all Jews, even those with a modest connection to the Torah, are like the Rimon, bursting with seeds of life, or Mitzvot.

MEN'S CLUB HAPPENINGS


Whith Purim coming up, I'm looking forward to seeing all of you in Shul to hear the Megillah and seeing your fantastic costumes.




